



Review Rocket League

The Rocket League game is a perfect match of soccer game but with cars and even more super cars that can also fly. The game is based on rewards where you can choose between several types of game modes. You can use the customization system to make a good representation in this fun little game

Today we are going to talk about one of the funniest games so far this year and that in fact is the sequel to the game released for Play Station 3 called Super Sonic acrobatics which many people do not know and have not played either. **Psyonix's new Rocket League** game has been downloaded + 5 million times in less than a month.

The description of this game is quite simple, it is soccer with remote control cars, it sounds ridiculous but the end result is surprisingly fun. The goal is to get the ball into the opponent's arc while defining your area.

The confrontations can be from 1 against 1 to 4 against 4 where the whole field becomes crazy especially because the goals are very frequent and turning a game can happen in seconds, for this the controls are quite intuitive and after a while being able to dominate the ball to make little games is extremely gratifying.

Ball behavior is sometimes difficult to predict, but this establishes a fun balance between skill and lack of control that keeps you hooked.

Another important element is the turbo which recharges each time it passes through specific points in the stadium. Having your load full at the right time becomes a key factor in scoring and at the same time allows you to blow up your enemies if you use it at the right time.

Each game lasts 5 minutes, in case there is a tie it goes to an additional time where a single goal defines the game and believe me this generates truly tense and memorable moments. Now every time they score a goal the ball returns to the middle, what they have to do is try not to touch the turbo in order to get there as fast as possible and be able to touch the ball. In general, all the cars are hitting each other trying to get to the ball, even if it is to touch it. They can also jump and head with the car. They can also climb on the walls and wait for the ball to drop before they can catch it.

All available cars are handled in a similar way but you can customize them by changing the paint or with items that you unlock gradually and you can even put the flag of your country if it is available.

Another point of **Download Rocket League** Free is that it allows you to play on a split screen with up to 4 players in the same room where screaming and pushing between legs are a natural part of the experience. The great thing is that without even beating you for a win it is very difficult not to have fun. Seeing how other people play in streaming is not nearly as entertaining as playing it in first person. If you are only the artificial intelligence of the computer it can be a good training although sometimes its behavior is somewhat irregular.

Described as "soccer, but with rocket-powered cars," the Missile League has up to four players assigned to each of the two teams that use rocket-powered vehicles to hit the ball in the opponent's goal and score points during the match. .

The game includes single and multiplayer modes that can be played both locally and online, including cross-platform play across all versions. Subsequent updates to the game made it possible to modify the basic rules and add new game modes, including those based on ice hockey and basketball.

Rocket League is a continuation of the Supersic Acrobatic Rocket Powered Psyonix Battle-Cars, a 2008 PlayStation 3 video game. Battle-Cars received mixed reviews and was not a great success, but it gained loyal fans.

Psyonix continued to support himself through work on developing contracts for other studios as he sought continuation. Psyonix began formal development of the Rocket League around 2013, refining Battle-Cars to criticize and contribute to fans.

Psyonix also noted the lack of marketing on the Battle-Cars website and participated in both social media and promotions, including offering free games for PlayStation Plus members for the premiere of the game.
